

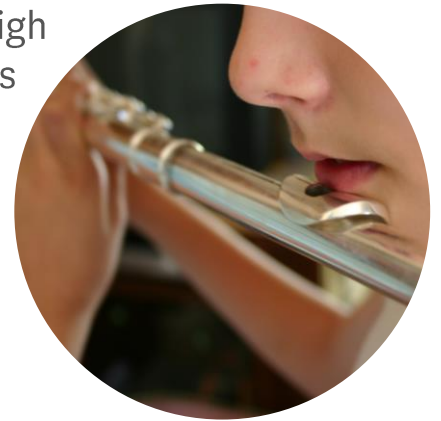

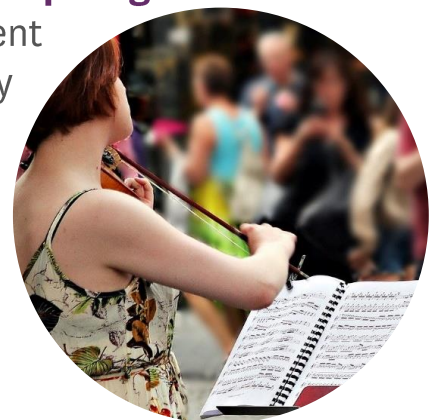
MUSIC PROGRAM IN HUNGARY

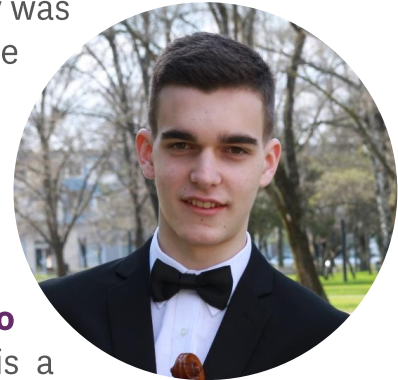
